

BOARD POLICY SERIES NUMBER: 1020

TITLE: CONFLICT OF INTEREST

It shall be the policy of Linn-Benton Community College that no Board of Education member or college employee shall have any pecuniary interest in the erection, repair, or furnishing of Linn-Benton Community College buildings or demand or receive any commission or compensation for purchase or sale of any Linn-Benton Community College supplies, equipment, or services directly to the college. College employees will not furnish for remuneration, whether at profit or loss, any required or optional materials for students or clients of the college. However, the administration of the college may grant individual exception to the policy if it deems such action to be compellingly in the best interest of students. Because students should have the freedom to purchase from any source, this policy is not intended to restrict students from incidental purchases from retail or other outlets in which board members or college employees have a financial interest.

It is the policy of Linn-Benton Community College that a Board of Education member of the college cannot simultaneously be an employee of Linn-Benton Community College.
